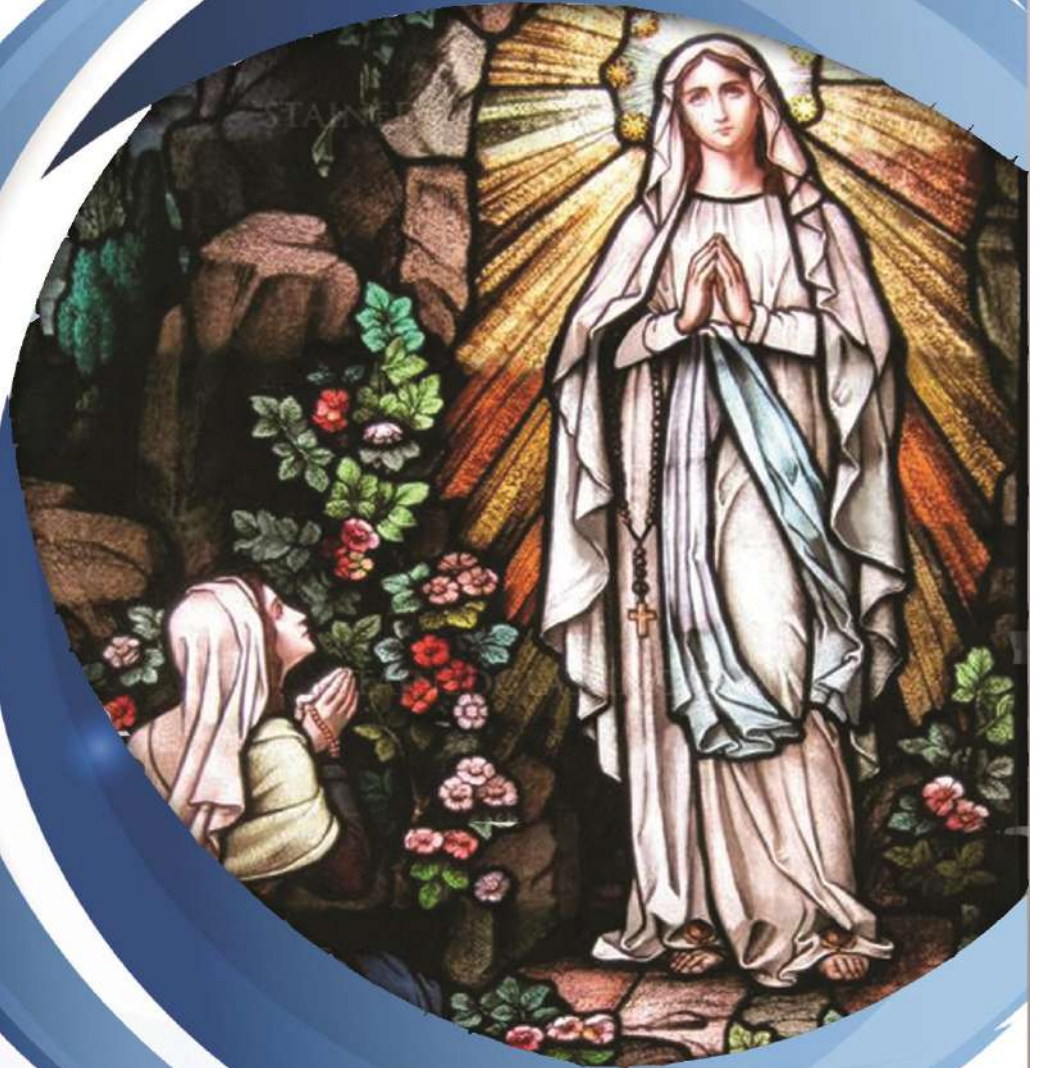

In this newsletter unlike in the previous ones we intend to give some bits of information for reflection, planning and execution in order to complete the action plan drawn during the provincial chapter 2011.

1) **House visits:** It is recommended that every school maintains a register exclusively to record the house visits undertaken by sisters (teaching) in the school to the students' houses. The format could be as simple as shown below.

2) **Children's day** this year could be celebrated with the theme of reaching out to the less fortunate children by planning a visit to the home of poor children or by bringing children from such homes to participate in some special programme organized for them.

3) In every school a project focused on **Protection/ Conservation of natural resources** should be started to conscientise in the stake holders and students the need to be agents of saving water and saving the Mother earth's resources. You can adapt the strategy *reduce - reuse- recycle*. Eg. 1. Categorizing the waste materials of the Classroom, pooling them together, sending them to recycle for reuse. Eg. 2. Preparation of manure from wet waste.

4) Teachers to be trained in different **Methods of teaching** to make the classroom lively and enjoyable. Models of teaching to be introduced by visits to innovative schools, interaction with teachers of other Schools, undergoing training for usage of modern technology in an effective way in the classrooms.

5) A **Suggestion box/ Notebook** to be made available to stakeholders (Teachers, Parents, Students & Others) to collect the views, opinions, grievances, appreciation etc to be brought into practice in every school.

6) Interschool sports events to be organized:

In order to enhance the sense of solidarity and integration among our students and teachers, annually an event of interschool competition in one or two game or match to be organized at province level. Further discussions will be held in regard to this at HM's meet.

7) It has been sadly realized that having crossed 88 years in our extension of educational service through various institutions we have not taken enough effort to build up and strengthen our associations with the Alumni. The commission suggests that every institution makes an annual action plan to realize the above by

having a mentor committee for **Alumni**.

8) **Annual calendar** specific to our province with significant activities indicated in it from April to March is in proposal to be prepared for the year 2018-19. Your creative suggestions are welcomed.

9) **School Archive:** A cupboard exclusively holding all the documents (records, files, registers) referring to the school activities from its commencement and articles like photos, magazines, newsletters etc to be maintained in every school. A catalogue of all articles in the cupboard should be also made available to anyone who takes up the office.

10) USM's peace convention at Cochin

will be probably from 29th December 2017 to 1st January 2018. The commission requests the heads of schools send representatives from both students and teachers' groups.

11) Some schools are yet to send their teachers' assessment report to Talentease. Let this be a reminder to respective schools to send the report asap.

12) **The Best Teacher Award** will be conferred to deserving teacher by the respective schools during the teachers' day celebration. The list of best teachers will be sent a week before the teachers day..
